## **Product Description**

The Ladera Heights gets its name because of it's high 72" platform, which children can climb up to using the Pod Climber. Once at the top, they can enjoy the view before taking a plunge down the huge Wave Slide. Elsewhere, kids will thrill as they zoom down a Left Turn Slide or cross the see-through Bones Bridge and tackle the Double Slide either on their own or with a friend.

Children can climb up or down from the structure using the Rock Hole Climber which doesn't provide specific grips like a climbing wall, but instead allows children to make their own foot and hand placement decisions. There's also a small cave underneath perfect for a game of hide-and-go-seek or exploring inside hoping to find a hibernating bear. A Gear Panel and Ship's Wheel top off the fun as a captain and a mechanic can work together to get their passengers across a roaring sea.
